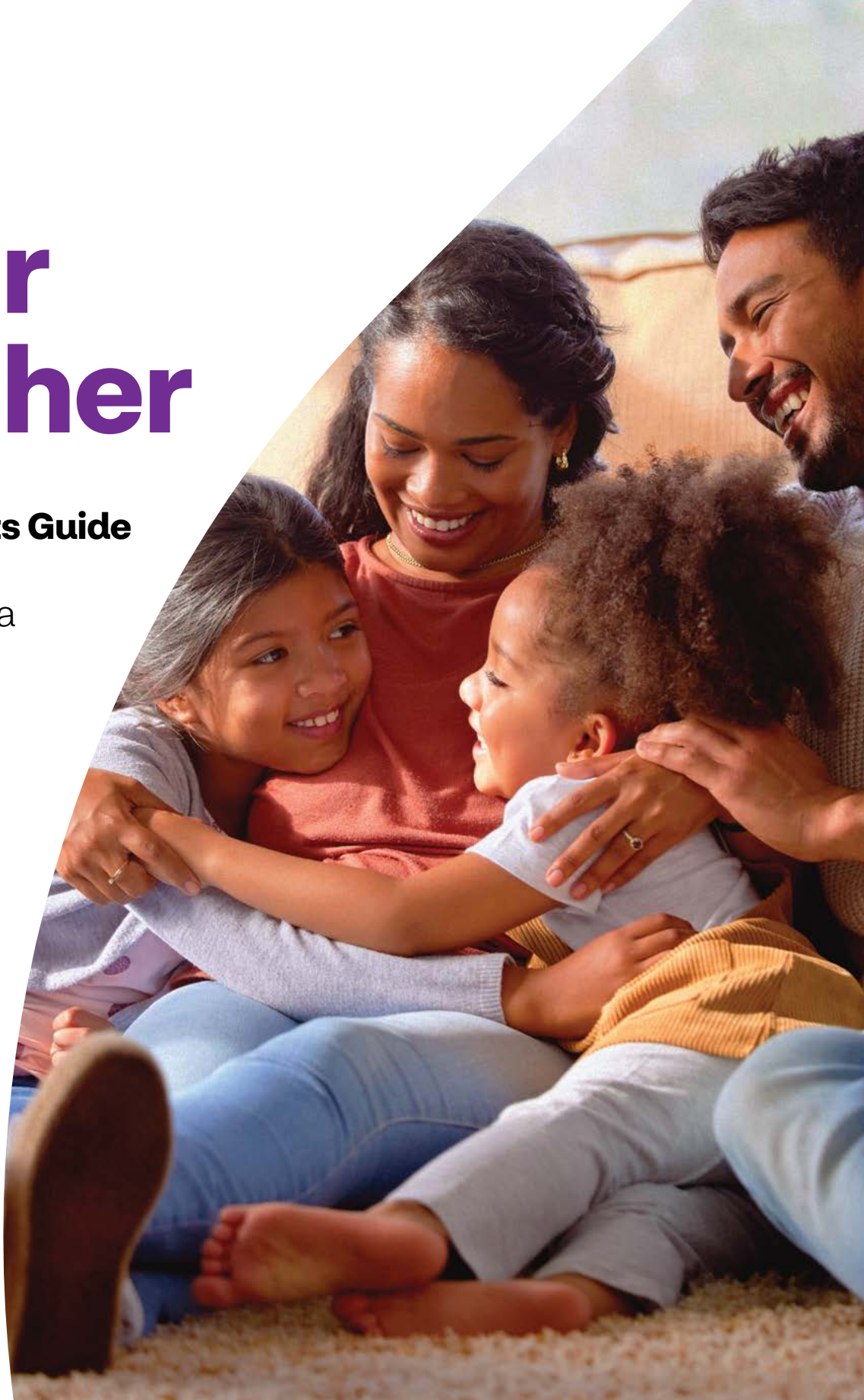

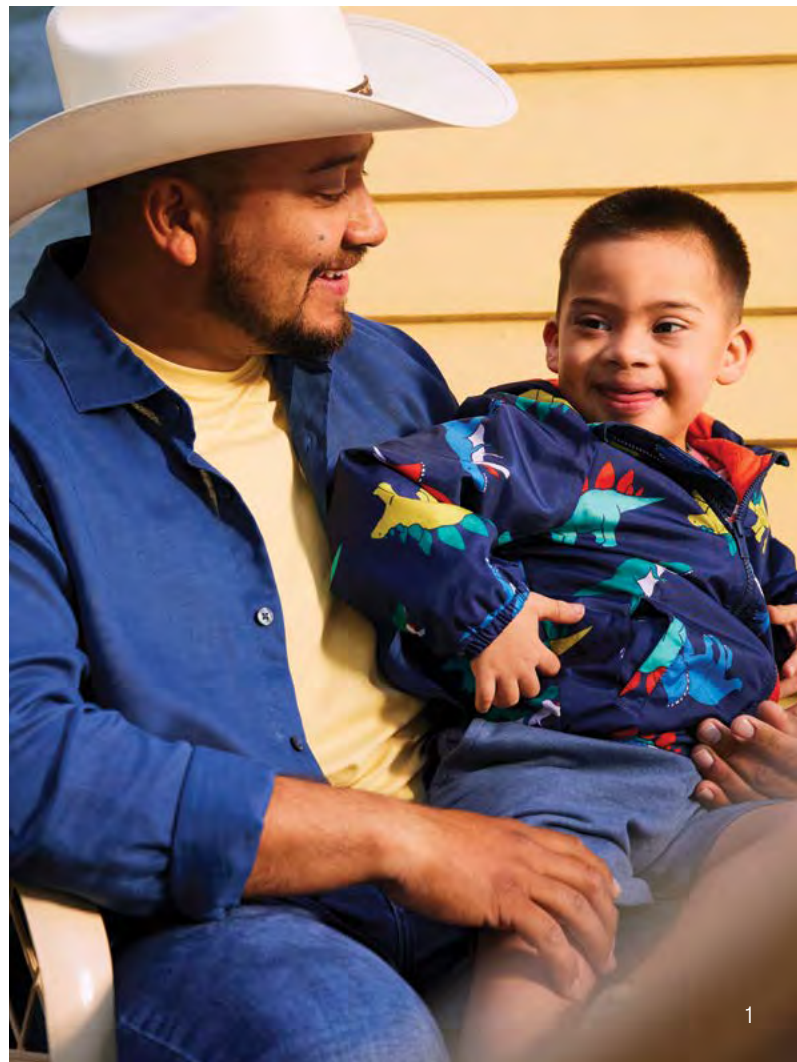

The right care when you need it

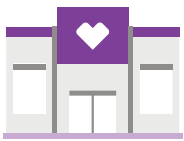
It's important to know where to go to get the care you need for the lowest cost. Of course, if you have a life-threatening illness or injury, don't wait — go to the nearest emergency room (ER) or dial 911.



Your doctor (primary care physician)

Aetna® plans give you the freedom to visit any doctor who is part of the Aetna network without a referral. However, working with a primary care physician gives you a chance to visit a doctor who will get to know your personal health care needs, medical history and background.

Always visit your doctor first, if possible.



Walk-in clinics

- Offer treatment for minor health issues, such as strep throat, ear infections, bronchitis and allergies
- Cost less than urgent care centers and ERs
- Are open extended hours and evenings
- Are usually located within a store or pharmacy



Urgent care centers

- Offer treatment for more serious health issues, such as fever, sprains, minor cuts and burns
- Cost slightly more than walk-in clinics but much less than the ER
- Have extended evening, weekend and holiday hours



ERs

- Are for life-threatening emergencies, such as chest pain, trouble breathing or severe bleeding
- Have the highest cost for treatment
- Are open 24/7
- Treat true emergencies first, often resulting in a long wait for non-urgent cases



In-network labs

Both Quest Diagnostics and Labcorp locations are in-network labs under the Aetna medical plans and offer a full range of lab services. You can also get in-network lab services at One Medical™ locations.

Virtual care

Many doctors now offer virtual visits online or through an app. The Aetna® medical plans cover virtual doctor visits the same as in-person visits. You also have the options below for connecting with a doctor, therapist or psychiatric mental health nurse practitioner (PMHNP) by phone or video.

How the Aetna® medical plans work

The Government of the District of Columbia offers three plan options:

1 Aetna HMO Plan Aetna Health Network OnlySM

Visit any in-network doctor.

You can visit any in-network doctor, facility or other provider. Out-of-network care is not covered. For most services, you pay a copay (a specific dollar amount) at the time of your care.

2 Aetna PPO Plan Open Choice® PPO

Visit any doctor in network or out of network.

The plan gives you the freedom to use any licensed provider, but you'll pay less when you stay in the network. Network providers also file claims for you.

3 Aetna Consumer-Driven Health Plan (CDHP) with Open Choice PPO

Take charge of your health care costs.

A consumer-driven health plan puts you, the consumer, in the driver's seat. You have the protection of a medical plan, with in- and out-of-network coverage. You also get a tax-free Health Savings Account (HSA) to help you pay for qualified health care expenses.

All three plans offer access to a national network of medical providers — without requiring a referral from your primary care physician (PCP). But it's a good idea to select a PCP because they get to know you and your health history.

How the CDHP works

The CDHP includes an HSA, which is separate from a Flexible Spending Account (FSA). HSA funds are yours to keep and spend on eligible health care expenses when and how you want.

Benefits of an HSA

- You choose an amount to contribute through payroll deductions.
- You enjoy a triple tax advantage:
 - Tax-free payroll contributions
 - Tax-free interest and investment earnings
 - Tax-free withdrawals to pay eligible expenses
- Funds roll over from year to year, and the account is yours to keep even if you leave the company.
- InspiraTM Financial administers your account. You can log in at [InspiraFinancial.com](https://www.inspirafinancial.com) or use the Inspira MobileTM app to manage your HSA.

How to get the most out of your CDHP

Build your HSA

Maximize your contributions. The maximum allowed contributions for 2026 are:

- \$4,400 for single coverage
- \$8,750 for family coverage

If you're age 55 or older, you can make an additional \$1,000 "catch-up" contribution.

Your HSA earns interest. And once your balance reaches \$1,000, you can start investing through Inspira Financial.

Use your HSA funds now or grow and save them for future health care expenses, even in retirement.

Shop smart for health care

Getting care in the Aetna® network will always cost less than getting care out of network. But you could save even more by comparing costs at different in-network facilities before you receive care. Use the cost estimator tool on your Aetna member website at [Aetna.com](https://www.aetna.com) or on the Aetna HealthSM app.
